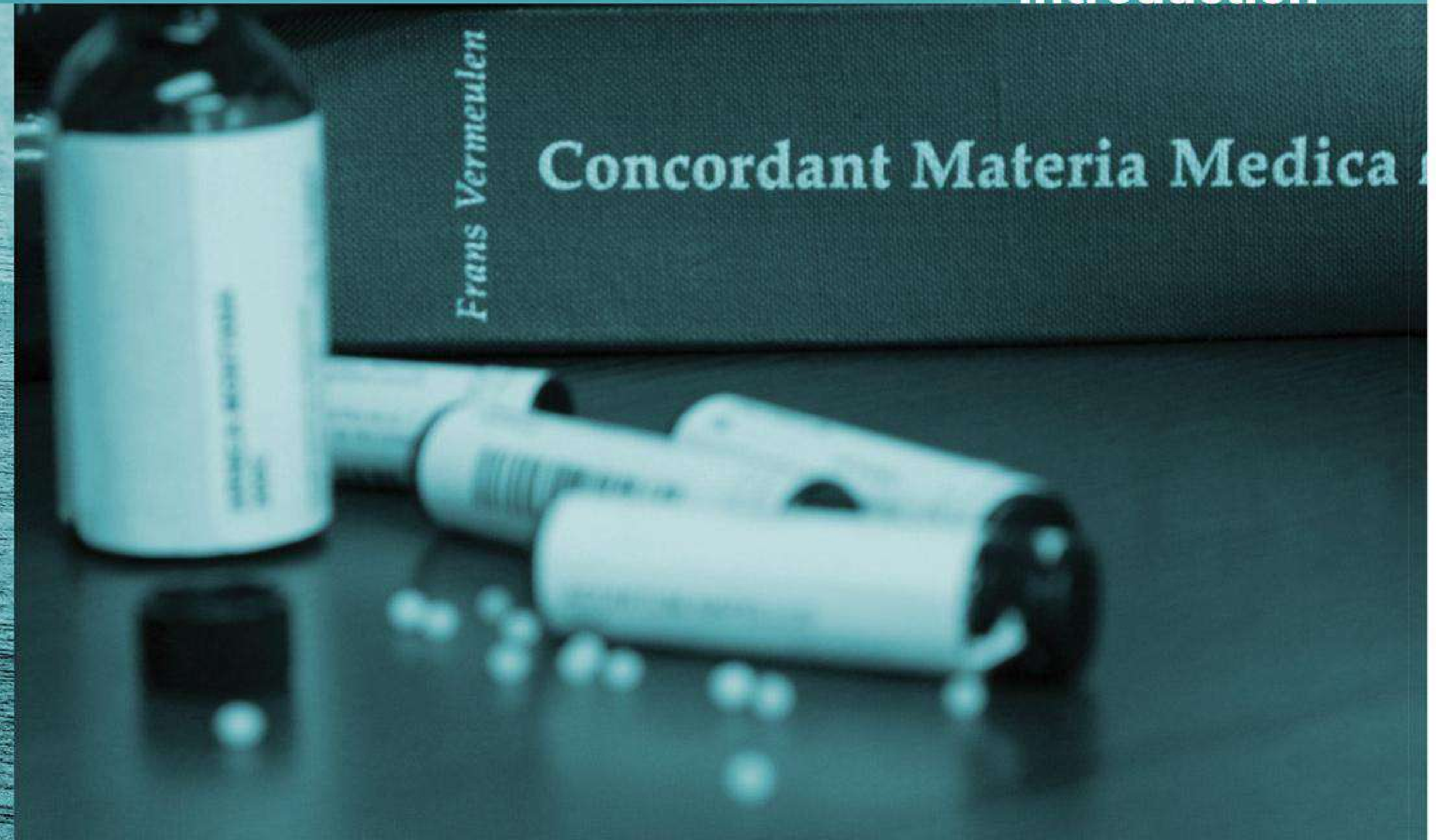
Vision

Introduction



The Motiwala Education and Welfare Trust was established in 1989 and started the National Homoeopathic Medical College in the same year. The college made a humble beginning, offering a Diploma certification, in a basement of 3000 sq.ft. with only two students on roll. Today, the college has grown into a post-graduate Institute spread amidst a 6-acre campus with a 10,000+ sq. ft. college building, equipped with its own hospital. The Institute offers dedicated departments in Anatomy, Physiology & Biochemistry, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Pathology, Microbiology & Bacteriology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Gynaecology & Obstetrics, Surgery & Orthopaedics and Community Medicine at the Under Graduate level along with Paediatrics, General Medicine, Organon of Medicine & Homoeopathic Philosophy, Repertory, Homoeopathic Materia Medica Departments at both under-graduate and post-graduate levels.



Curriculum Design & Development

Curriculum Design and Development

The curriculum for undergraduate B.H.M.S course and M.D. (Homoeopathy) course is designed and developed by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi.

At the college level, the departments prepare term-wise advanced teaching programmes according to the domains of learning. Due importance is given to practical and participative learning of each subject. Experts in the field of General Medicine and Homoeopathy are invited as guest faculty. Students feedback at the end of academic year forms the basis for enrichment of curriculum each year.

The college imparts the five and half years degree course in Homoeopathy leading to **Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (BHMS)**. This course comprises of four examinations and one year compulsory rotator Internship.

The M.D. Homoeopathy courses are recognised by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and Government of Maharashtra and are currently affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Eligibility criteria

- The Student should have passed the 4 and ½ years of undergraduate course in Homoeopathy, recognised by the Central Council of Homoeopathy.
- He/She should have completed One year compulsory rotatory internship.
- He/She should have qualified in **PG-NEET**(Homoeopathy) examination.

Student enrolment and profile

Students are enrolled as per the merit obtained through State / Central Entrance Examination. 15% quota seats are filled by the management strictly on the basis of merit obtained at the qualifying examination.

Student diversity

Students from different states of India study together in the campus. We have students coming from Jammu & Kashmir, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Meghalaya and Gujarat.

Teaching, Learning & Evaluation

Students are encouraged to learn in a participatory manner. This is achieved through Clinical Presentations, Tutorials and Seminars, Group Discussions, Quiz, etc.

Teacher quality

The institute is having highly qualified and experienced staff in all the Departments. Local reputed practitioners in the field of allied subjects and Homoeopathy are called to engage guest lectures. The staff is encouraged to participate in Continued Learning by attending the re-orientation programmes conducted by the University and the Central Council from time to time. The institute sponsors the staff attending National and International conferences.

Evaluation process

The students are evaluated by the annual examinations held by the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences. The students are required to appear at the theory and practical examinations held by the university.

Students are required to pass both the theory and practical examinations separately in order to pass in a subject.

Student Performance & Learning outcome

The institute has a higher rate of student performance at the university examinations. Students of this institute have secured University Ranks and Gold medals. Our overall result is above the university average result in each examination held by the university.

Promotion of Research Consultancy & Extension

The institute is committed to the promotion of Homoeopathic science through research. The students are encouraged to conduct various research projects during their study and during internship, it is mandatory for interns to submit a dissertation of the topic of their research. The institute has constituted an Ethical Committee to see into the relevance, feasibility and socio-economic implications of the research projects.

Dr. F. F. Motiwala, Dr. T. K. Kundu and Dr. Kamlesh Bagmar have published their research article “Effect of Homoeopathic treatment on activity of daily living (ADL) in Knee Osteoarthritis : A prospective observational study in Indian Journal of Homoeopathy, Vol. 10, Issue 3, July - Sept. 2016 in collaboration with ICMR, KEM Hospital, Mumbai & HFI. A research paper titled Homoeopathic Medicine substantially reduces the need of clotting factor concentrate in a severe haemophilia patient: a blinded Placebo Control Crossover Trial, got published in **Elsevier Homoeopathy Journal**.

Extension Activities and Institutional Social Responsibility

The Motiwala Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital is providing the health care services at the remote places of tribal areas of Peth, Surgana and in Gujarat State up to Ahwadang through regular Medical Camps. Since last 20 years, the college and hospital is successfully running domiciliary Health Check-up services at the door step of the society around the hospital by adopting the poor and needy families. With the help of Department of Community Medicine, the interns and students visit the adopted families every Saturday and thereby improving not only the health of the family, but problems like illiteracy, addictions, unemployment & hygiene are also sorted out at different levels. The awareness programs and campaigns are conducted regularly to improve the health and hygiene in the adopted areas. The special health check up schedule is focused to provide the medical help to improve the health of the young girls and boys in the schools. Due to this programme, the students and interns get familiar with the society, mix up easily and can understand the basic causes of the routine medical problems. This programme helps to build the ideal citizenship in the students and interns.

Infrastructure & Facilities

The Hospital is the soul of any medical college. The Institute runs its own well equipped Multi-Specialty Hospital, with a capacity of 50 beds, including the Intensive Care Unit and Neonatal Care Unit.

The Outpatient and Inpatient departments of the hospital provide adequate clinical material for the students of the college and interns, for their observation, experience and to learn the clinical applications. The patients get the benefit of Homoeopathic treatment for various illnesses at charitable rates.

The Hospital has a modern ICU (Intensive Care Unit) with latest Multi-Para Monitors, Ventilators, Defibrillators and Centralized oxygen to provide the life saving emergency care, treatment and management for 24 hrs. The college and hospital is successfully running Domiciliary Health Check-up Services at the door step of the society around the hospital by adopting the poor and needy families.

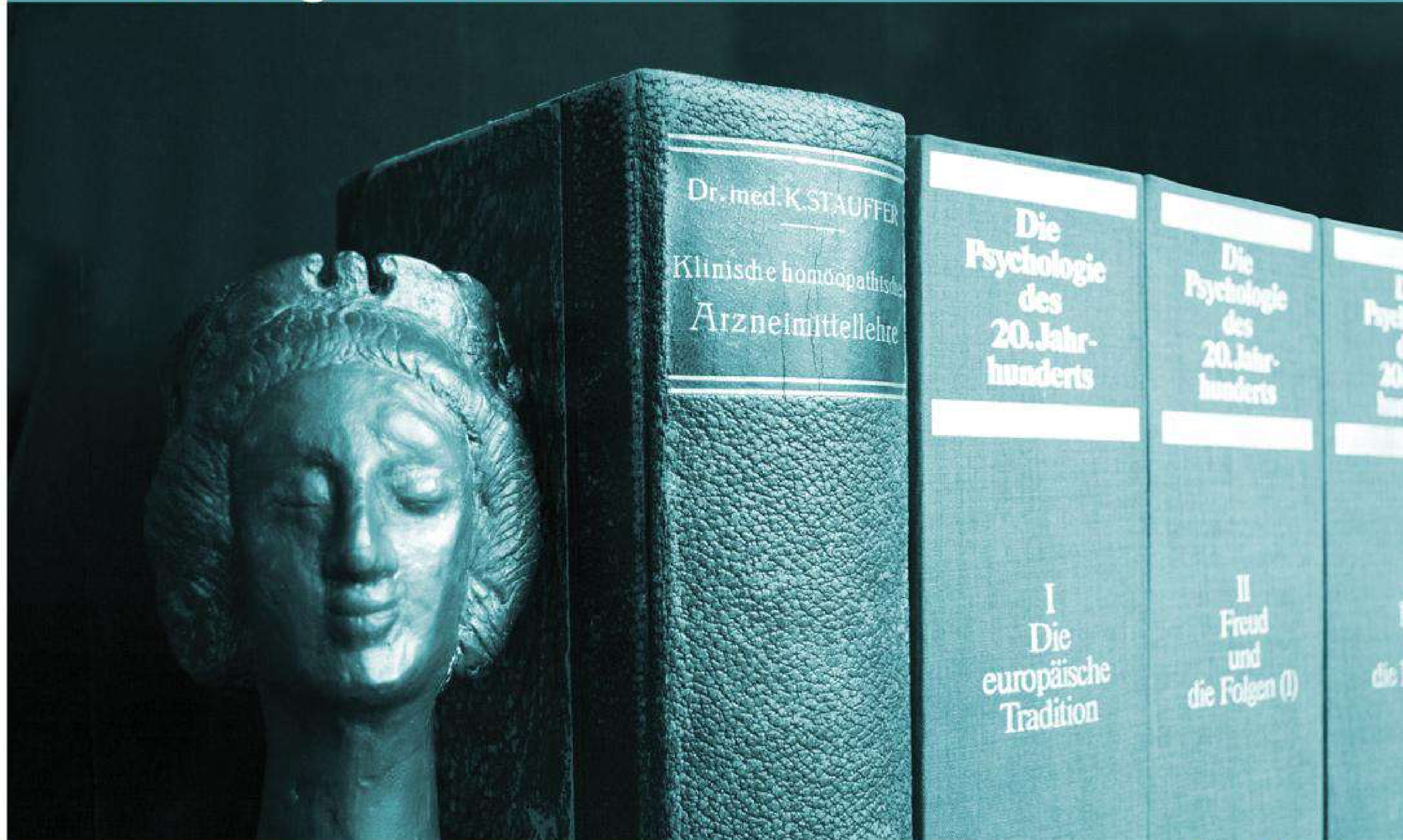

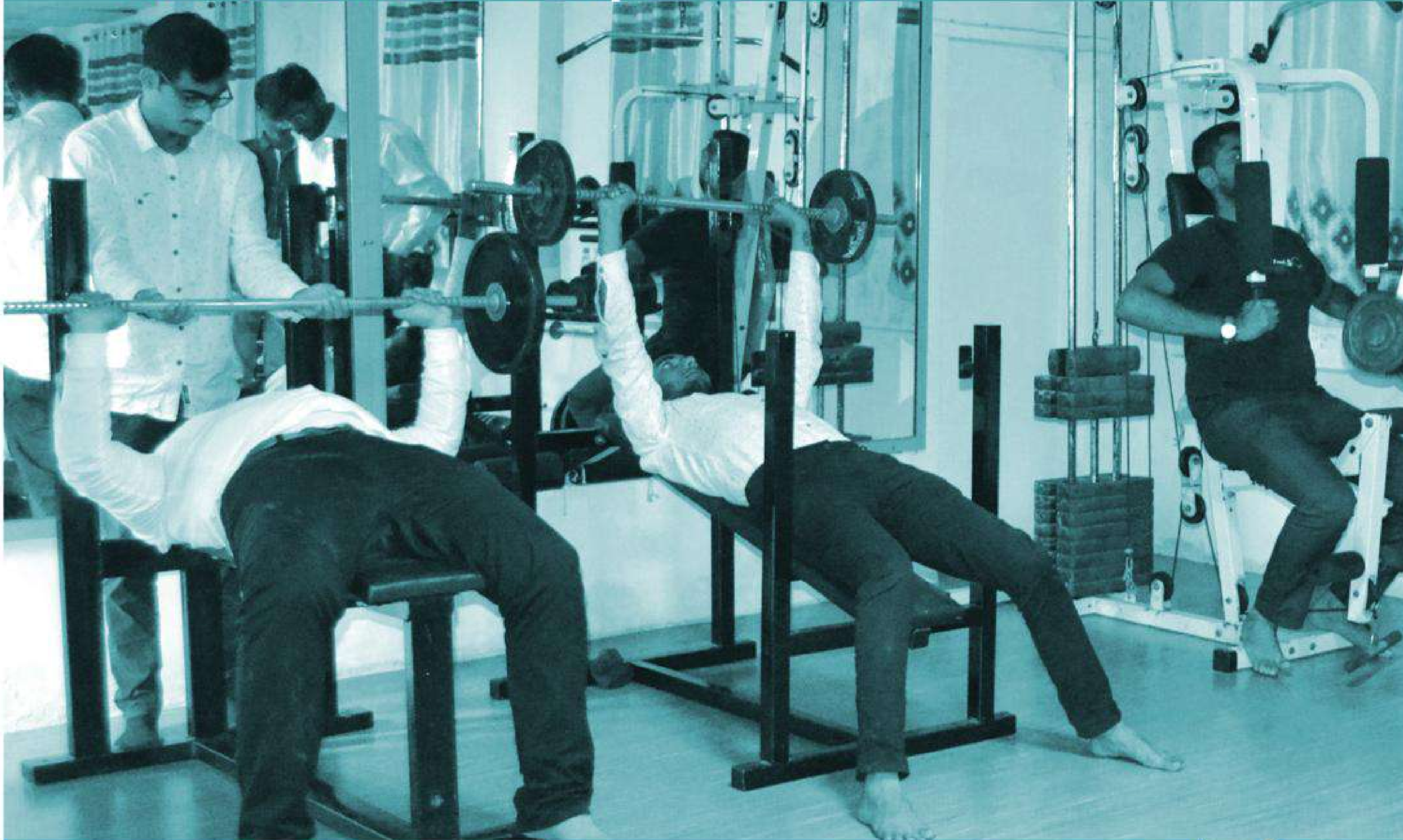

Student Mentoring and Support

Teachers are assigned as mentors and in charge of the student's activities and support. Student Progression is monitored on regular basis and their performance is appraised to the parent and guardians of the students. Parent -Teacher Meetings are arranged to discuss the academic progress and other personal difficulties of the students.

Hostel

Girls Hostel is present inside the campus. The rooms are self contained with balcony. Delicious food is served in the dining hall, adjacent to which, is an entertainment zone with television. Though the college has no Boys hostel in the campus, the male students are assisted by the Student Welfare Department / Administrative office for providing a decent accommodation.

Innovation & Best Practices

Environmental Consciousness

The Management of the institute has always been conscious about the preservation of the environment. As a gesture of Environmental protection and preservation, our guests and invitees are always greeted with a sapling of Neem plant, instead of bouquets. The case presentation by the students and the dissertation during the compulsory rotatory Internship is an innovation by the institute towards promotion of participative learning.

Spiritual Awareness

Healing is of two kinds say the Baha'i writings. “One is when practiced as a science, as is normally done by the different medical professionals, by the

employment of medicines and therapies”. The second and more potent when practiced, is the spiritual healing which in modern days has found many expressions as in Reiki, Pranic healing, etc. Dr. Samuel Hahnemann, a spiritual person, expressed his gratitude to the Good Lord for the Science of Homoeopathy. The spiritual empowerment program conducted by this institution comprises of the curriculum as developed by the Ruhi Institute in British Columbia. The Ruhi Book -I enriches the students understanding of human virtues, strengthens their faith in prayer & meditation and creates a realization of the higher purposes of our existence.

Universal Human Value Education

The college now has collaboration with the Baha'i Academy for training students in the unique participatory course consisting of Six modules called as the Universal Human Value Education as developed by Wilmette institute in Chicago, USA.

Personality Development and Public Speaking

The Institution encourages the spirit of “Dignity in Humanity”. Every student learns to grow in an atmosphere of respect, obedience and discipline. Students are taught that “Discipline achieves what Ambition seeks”. The art of good and elegant dressing is insisted upon.

Regular seminars, daily assemblies, assignments, presentations and Viva-Voce form the basis of Personality development and Public Speaking. Regular talks and seminars by eminent speakers serve to guide the students and train them.

Anti-Ragging

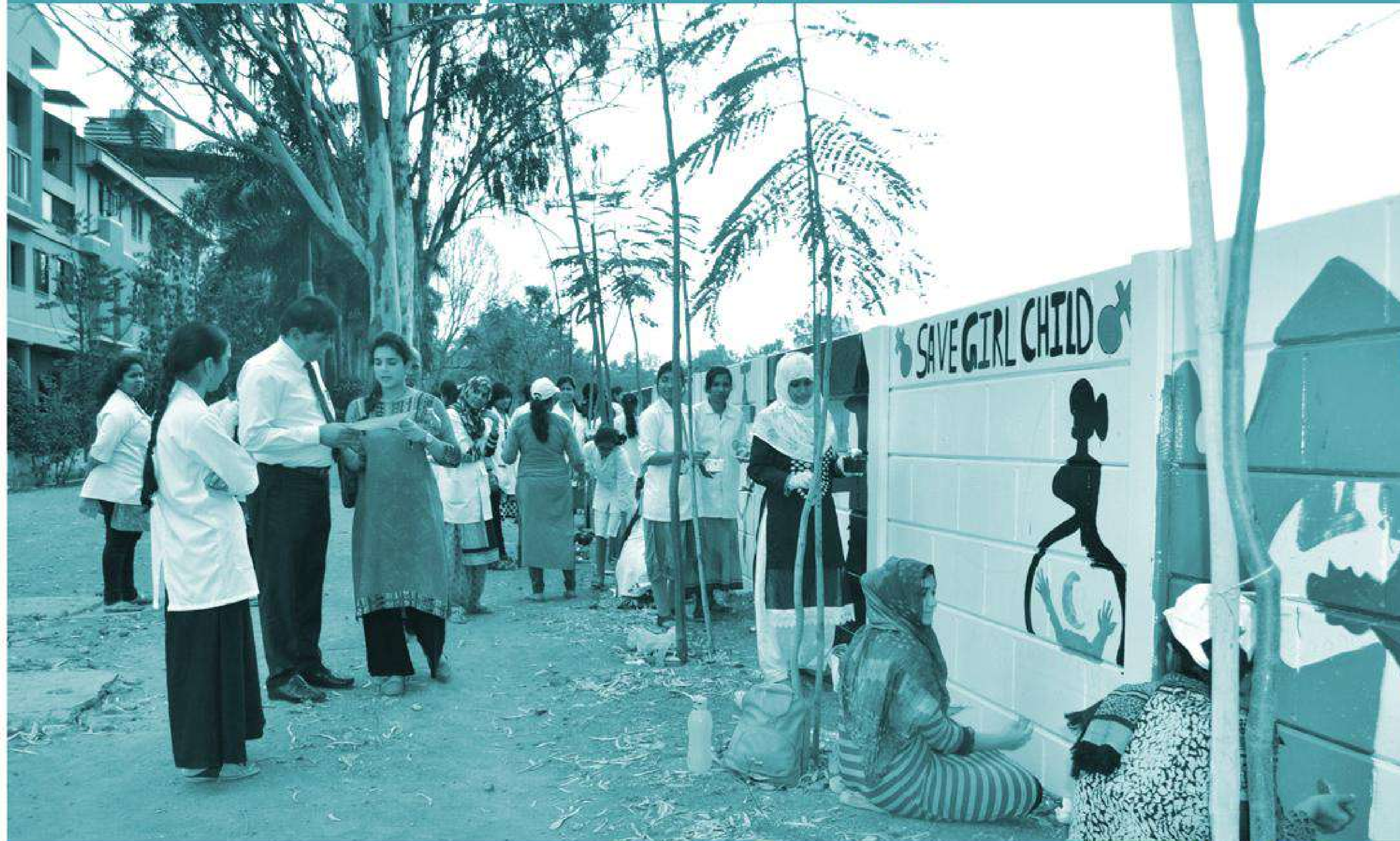
The college has a strict code of behavior, dress code, ethics & attendance monitoring system. Failure to comply with the code of conduct will attract punishment.

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited inside and outside of the campus. An Anti-Ragging committee & Anti-Ragging squad is vigilant of such activities. Any student involved in ragging or abetting it, will be dismissed from college and a police complaint is lodged against such student. The same shall be informed to the University. The student shall face prosecution as per the Anti-Ragging Act.

Materia Novum - The Journal of Homoeopathy

The college presently publishes a quarterly peer-reviewed Journal of Homoeopathy “Materia Novum”. This journal has a collection of research articles, review articles, case reports, etc.

Student participation and activities

Clinical presentation

To enhance the clinical skills among our undergraduate students of the third and fourth year, the college has inculcated the culture of the bi-annual project of Clinical Presentations. This will not only consolidate their knowledge but also polish their personality and develop self confidence and stage presence, which is an essential component of medical practice.

Dissertation

Development of research acumen in the students has always been one of the priorities of our institute. With this aim, the interns are required to take up a research project during their compulsory rotatory internship. Few of our projects have been selected and awarded at the inter-university research competition- “AVISHKAR”.

Domiciliary Health Care System Program

Our students conduct regular visits to the house-holds adopted by them in the vicinity of college and assess the health status, providing medical care



for the needy. They also educate inmates of the house regarding hygiene and complete diet. A record of the activity is maintained by the students under the supervision of the Department of Community Medicine.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The college is having a unit of National Service Scheme under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, rendering services to the rural population of the Nashik district. Our college unit is awarded the Best NSS unit by the Health University. Our Unit conducts regular medical camps in adopted villages

Study tour

The college conducts a study tour every year for the students of the First year B.H.M.S. in which students visit Homoeopathic Pharmaceutical industries and Laboratories. Students also get an opportunity to visit hill-stations and other nearby tourist locations. The tours spans for about 8 to 10 days during the months of January & February each year.

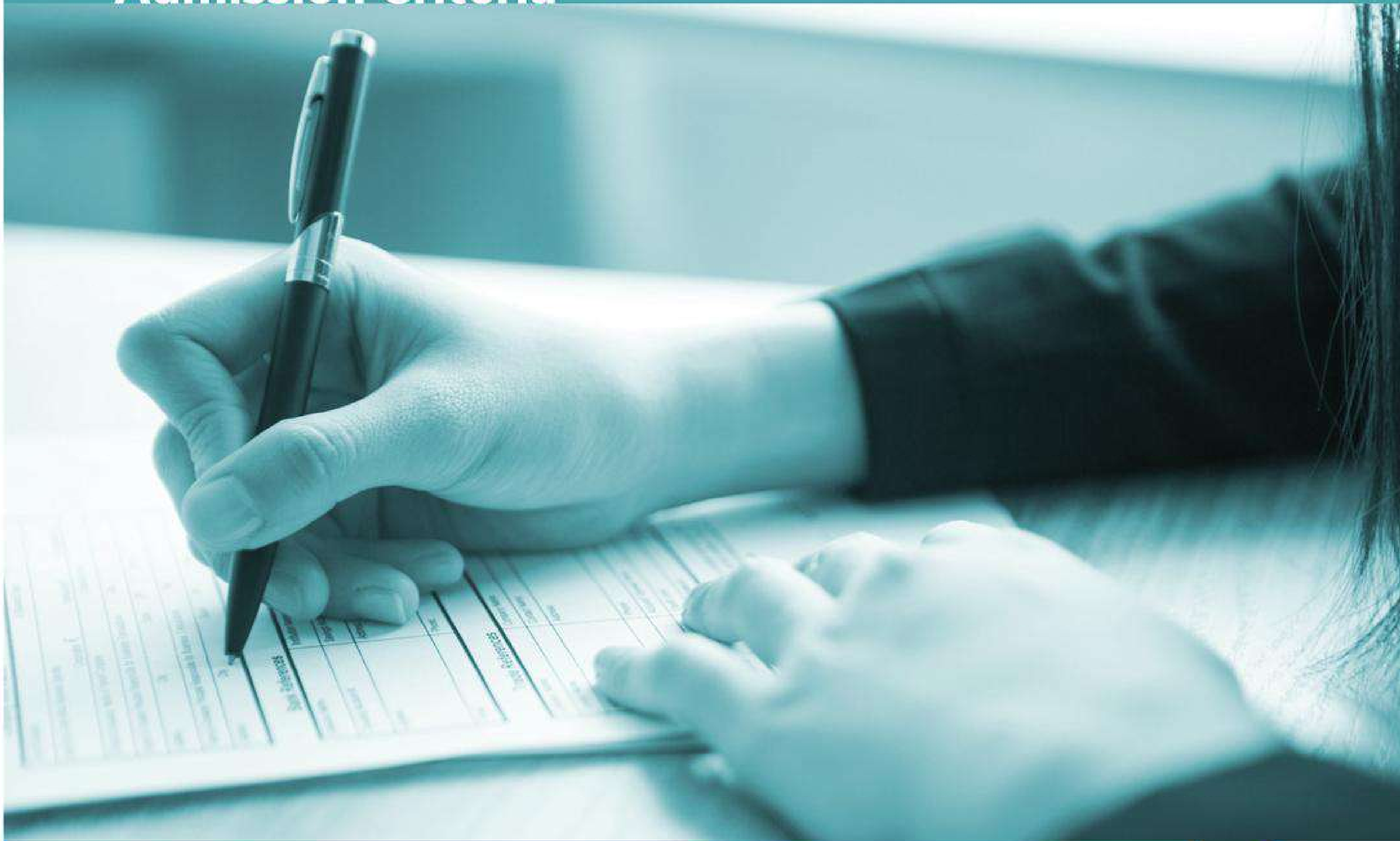
Annual Gathering

Admission Criteria

Eligibility

Student should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission. A candidate should have passed the 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English OR its equivalent examination. Students from other countries must produce a equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. Students should have appeared for NEET examination.

Documents to be produced

1. **Proof of Age:** Birth Certificate
2. **Proof of Qualification:** Marks Sheet and Passing certificate of qualifying examination.
3. **Equivalency Certificate** in case of students coming from other countries
4. **Medical Fitness Certificate:** Certificate issued by a qualified physician
5. **Nationality Certificate:** Attested copy of the passport or Certificate issued by the collector's office of the place of residence of the student.
6. **Caste Validity Certificate** for the students applying in the reservation category quota.

7. **NEET** examination Passing certificate / Mark sheet
8. **Gap Certificate:** In case students do not join any course after passing the qualifying examination, and there is lapse of considerable period, such students are required to produce a Gap Certificate. This certificate should be issued by the institute where the student last studied and an affidavit from the student stating his occupation in lapsed period i.e., the gap between his passing of qualifying examination and the time of admission.

Application Procedure

General Quota

Students seeking admission should have appeared for NEET examination in the year in which they seek admission.

(Students are advised to contact college office for details regarding admission procedure, as these rules tend to change from time to time.)

Fee structure

Fee structure will be in accordance to the approved fee structure for the college approved by the “Fee Regulatory Authority”

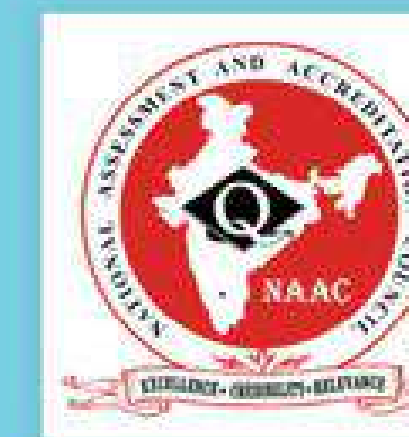

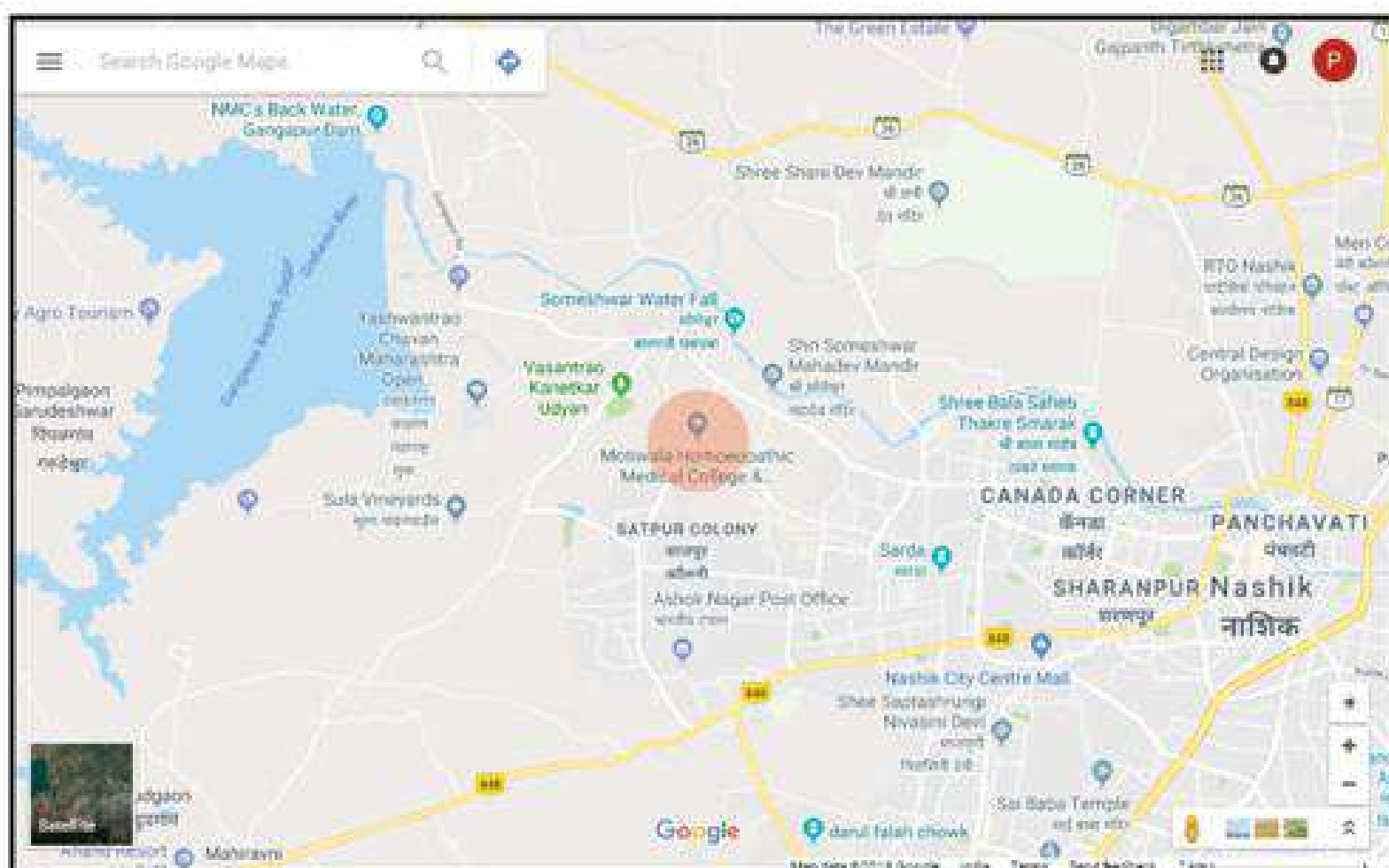

Motiwala Homoeopathic Medical College is situated in the historic holy city of Nashik, which would be soon called as a second Silicon valley of Maharashtra. It is located in between the two major cities of Maharashtra i.e., Mumbai and Pune and linked to them by road ways and railway. It is just 180 Km from Mumbai Airport i.e., it takes not more than 3½ hrs by rail route.

Climate

The city of Nashik is situated on the Sahyadri ranges of mountains approximately 600 meters above mean sea level and hence Nashik is blessed with a temperate climate. The summers are tolerable with average temperature of 34-36° C. The monsoons too are comfortable.

The campus is situated at a distance from the main city of Nashik, yet well connected. The campus nests in peaceful and serene atmosphere, which is learner- friendly.
