
5) The duty timings of all hospital doctors and their regularity was assessed.


3) Covid guidelines were followed strictly in Hospital. Presentation given by Dr. S. M. Yadav of the same, members checked out the things by visiting hospital premises.

Meeting started with a prayer


- 1) Review of previous IQAC meeting with implementation of same were present.
